



## Event Rules & Timings

### Ladies Dinghy Race

6:30 to 7:30pm

A dinghy containing four ladies must go across the mouth of the marina, pick up two additional competitors and return to the starting point. No oars are permitted and all participants must remain in the boat. Heats are contested with the winner of each heat going in to the grand final.

#### Prizes

- Best Fancy Dress Case of Wine

### Raft Race

7:30 to 8:15pm

New event for 2009 for teams of six to race their made-made raft from Shale beach to a buoy and back. Course situated in Careening Hard (Harbour behind the boat house). Event is limited to nine team entries. There will be three races of three rafts. The first team back in each race will go through to the final. As long as the competitors are on the raft, their legs can be in the water. Home made paddles are allowed.

#### Prizes

- Winners of the Event Harbour Carnival Trophy plus £100
- Best Raft Harbour Carnival Trophy plus Case of Bubbly

### Tug of war

8:15 to 9:00pm

Two teams participate in this traditional event, with the twist that they are side by side, not opposing one another. The rope goes across the mouth of the harbour with a pulley the other side. The losing team is the one that ends the bout by falling into the harbour. There is a 600KG weight limit for each team. Teams can be single-sex or mixed. Heats are contested with a grand final.

#### Prizes

### Man-Powered Flight

9:00 to 9:30pm

The aim of the event is to launch a craft containing one or more people off an elevated platform on the Crown Pier into the harbour. Prizes are awarded for the longest distance and the best craft. No engine or propellant is permitted.

- Best Plane Harbour Carnival Trophy plus £50

### Truck Pull

Throughout the night until 9:00pm

Teams of two (two competitions open class & mixed) pull a truck over a set distance. The quickest time wins each class. There is an entry fee of £10 per team per event. This entitles the competitors to unlimited Truck Pulls until 9:00 to see who the fastest team is.

- Winners of Mixed Event Harbour Carnival Trophy plus additional prize
